- Help in the maintenance of the fabric and to fund specific projects.



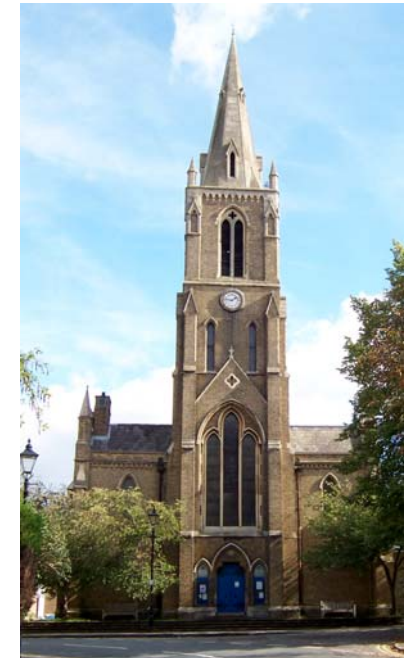
### Friends' Sponsored Future Projects:
